Venue and Date: Nairobi 20-25 November 2008

#### a) Summary

This workshop is held in collaboration with Regional Capacity Building Partners which held a similar one in Lusaka , Zambia , between 26-30 May, 2008. It recognizes that in recent years, HIV&AIDS responses have grown significantly but with the impact of such programme is seldom adequately measured, documented or shared with others. The need to demonstrate impact and change in the quality of lives of people is becoming a critical concern for donors, NGOs and other stakeholders. Unfortunately, the capacity to assess impact on an on-going basis and make the results of such assessments part of the continuous process of planning and implementing HIV & AIDS programmes is still weak in many developing countries.

Programme managers, programme officers in charge of monitoring and evaluation, and staff of government departments and NGOs who wish to improve their reporting systems and promote impact assessment.
